Council of Europe and Unesco Global Education prepares for World Summit 2010

Council of Europe has taken an initiative to bring together Unesco Global Education and World Summit to define their role of media education and international policies in media within the Summit. It is a truly interesting initiative and the involvement of Council of Europe and Unesco Global Education will strengthen media education and policies in the Summit.

21st Century Teaching Skills

The 21st Century Teaching Skills will be a full program for international teachers on all school levels, from Pre School to university. The Summit is preparing a program for media educators and media education to strengthen Media Literacy and media competence.

Global Youth Council

The Summit 2010 is working hard to involve children and youth and that is why the project Global Youth Council opened in December 2008. The Global Youth Council involves a number of international youth groups, coordinated by Karlstad Youth Council, a group of six young students who are interested in United Nation's Child Convention, article 17 about mass media, and how to bring forward perspectives and interest from children and youth. Through a web page at wskarlstad2010.se and through a chat forum they will discuss a number of issues related to the summit in order to prepare for the Youth Declaration.

Global Culture Festivities

World Summit is preparing for tourism and culture events and the Global Culture Festivities with interesting activities for all delegates during the Summit next year. For instance, World Summit is cooperating with the City of Karlstad and different tourism companies in search of most exciting activities. A full activity program within the World Summit 2010 will be presented in August this year.

* The work with the program draft is to be completed. The full program will be presented early in September this year.


* Organisation of the participation of children and youth during the summit.
